## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

### **1. Introduction**

The KEMBARA PERTAMA 2008+ will have two categories . one for participants in the Media and Media-related disciplines and the other for the general public. The hunt will run from Kuala Lumpur to Kuantan, Pahang on Saturday 21 June 2008.

### **2. Theme & Objectives**

The hunt will help to:

- a. Promote cooperation among the participants.
- b. Foster the spirit of goodwill.
- c. Foster the spirit of camaraderie.
- d. Facilitate acquiring of knowledge and information.
- e. Encourage critical thinking.
- f. Promote safe driving.
- g. Create fun and enjoyment.

### **3. Participation & Entry Fee**

Participation is open to two or four persons per vehicle. The entry fee per participant is RM120 (member) and RM150 (media and public). The entry fee entitles each participant to one-night accommodation at Swiss Garden Resort & Spa in Kuantan, Pahang (on a twin-sharing basis), one dinner, one breakfast and a T-shirt.

### **4. Submission of Entry Forms**

## **5. Collection of Goodies & Briefing**

Participants can collect the t-shirts, stickers and goodies between 1700 and 1800 hours on Thursday 19 June, 2008 at Wisma Bernama, Kuala Lumpur. A briefing will be held for all participants at the same premises at 1800 hours.

## **6. Venue of Start and Finish**

The hunt will start at Wisma Bernama in Kuala Lumpur and ends at a leading hotel in Kuantan, Pahang. Flag-off in Kuala Lumpur will be at 0700 hours on Saturday 21 June, 2008. All participants must be at the venue by 0600 hours for verification of entry. Final briefing by the clerk-of-course will be at 0645 hours.

## **7. Prizes**

Attractive prizes, including cash await the winners.

## **8. Eligibility of Vehicles**

All participating vehicles must comply with the Road Transport Act and are eligible for use on public roads. Vehicles entered for this hunt cannot carry any trade plate. Participants must have adequate knowledge of their vehicles and should be able to present the vehicles for an inspection, if necessary, before the start of the event.

It is recommended that the vehicles be equipped with a speedometer with reading in kilometres and a trip meter (which is a standard feature in all vehicles). It is also recommended that participants bring along safety gadgets such as a vehicle fire extinguisher, a first-aid box and so on.

## **9. Insurance and Indemnity**

The organiser and sponsors cannot be held responsible for any accident that the participants or vehicles may be involved in during the event, or for violation of traffic rules and regulations by the participants.

Participants are fully responsible for the safety of themselves and their families or relatives and friends, and cannot make any claims against the organiser, sponsors or other officers.

Drivers must be in possession of a valid insurance policy that covers them against third-party liability. **Drivers, navigators and passengers must sign the indemnity form attached to the entry form.**

## **10. The Rights of the Organiser**

The organiser retains the right to:

- a. reject any entry.
- b. cancel or postpone the hunt, without notice, should there be less than 30 entries or for unavoidable reasons. Any claim arising out of the cancellation or postponement will not be entertained.
- c. deny participation of any person or vehicle after inspection shows their ineligibility.
- d. deny participation of any person felt to be unsuitable for participation for health reasons, deformity or instability due to being under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- e. dismiss any participant who brings along additional passengers whose names have not been entered in the entry form.

## **11. Caution**

The Pertama Treasure Hunt is not a race and, as such, speed will not contribute towards winning. A speeding offence may result in penalty points and disqualification.

## **12. Interpretation of Rules**

The organiser and clerk-of-course of the hunt reserve the right to determine any matter not stated in the rules and regulations.

**(Supplementary rules will be issued during the briefing on 19 June, 2008 and will be binding on all participants.)**
