RULES & REGULATIONS

Hospis Malaysia 8th Charity Treasure Hunt 2009 (25th – 26th July 2009)

1. The Hospis Malaysia 8th Charity Treasure Hunt 2009 is a Motoring Treasure Hunt lasting for about 8 hours. At some point it is necessary to get down and obtain answers at the heritage sites.
2. Entry forms must be fully completed and the indemnity declaration duly signed by all participants in the team. Only official entry forms will be accepted. Fees must be fully paid by **10th July 2009** before the application can be officially accepted and processed.
3. A team shall comprise a minimum of 2 to a maximum of 4 participants.
4. The driver and navigator must possess a valid driving license and the vehicle must be covered by a valid road tax and insurance.
5. A briefing will be held on **24th July, 2009** at **6pm** at **Hospis Malaysia Day Care Centre** (tentative).
6. The organiser reserves the rights to amend the rules, change or postpone the date, or cancel the event if it is deemed necessary.
7. Entry Fees per team are as follows :
 - a) RM 180 per person (with accommodation*) for driver/navigator/2 passengers
The fee will include 1 night stay at Kampung Stay (Kg. Batu Kikir, Padang Lebar, Kuala Pilah), 1 Evening Tea, 1 Dinner & 1 Breakfast
 - b) RM 100 per person (without accommodation*) for driver/navigator/2 passengers
The fee will include 1 Evening Tea, 1 Dinner & 1 Breakfast.

8. The decision of awarding prizes and points by the judges will be final.
9. All payments by cash or cheque (crossed) must be made payable to **HOSPIS MALAYSIA**. Payment can also be made via direct remittance to HOSPIS MALAYSIA's MAYBANK account **5141-3212-1211**. (*Please attach a copy of bank in slip with the entry form*).
10. At least 1 team member from each team must attend the Registration and Briefing and he/she/they shall be responsible for disseminating all information provided at the briefing session to all other team members.
11. Competition numbers and various car stickers provided by the Organiser must be placed on participating vehicle as directed by the Organiser, and these must remain on the vehicle throughout the Hunt. No other form of advertising other than those provided by the Organiser shall be permitted.
12. Participants are required to comply with the dress code for the event as determined by the Organiser.
13. All materials of whatsoever nature in relation to the Hunt (whether submitted as a 'found treasure" in the Hunt or otherwise) shall belong to the Organiser and no participant shall have any claim thereto.
14. The Organiser shall be entitled to use any materials derived from the event in any form or for any purpose that the Organiser deems fit.

***Please be informed that accommodation availability at Kampung Stay, Padang Lebar, Kuala Pilah is on a first come first serve basis. The organiser reserves the right to allocate accommodation for all participants.**
