



RULES & REGULATIONS

9th Hospis Malaysia Charity Treasure Hunt 2010 (24th – 25th April 2010)

1. The 9th Hospis Malaysia Charity Treasure Hunt 2010 is a Motoring Treasure Hunt lasting for about 8 hours. At some point it is necessary to get down and obtain answers at the sites.
2. Entry forms must be fully completed and the indemnity declaration duly signed by all participants in the team. Only official entry forms will be accepted. Fees must be fully paid by **17th April 2010** before the application can be officially accepted and processed.
3. A team shall comprise a minimum of 2 to a maximum of 4 participants.
4. The driver and navigator must possess a valid driving license and the vehicle must be covered by a valid road tax and insurance.
5. A briefing will be held on **23rd April, 2010 at 6pm at Hospis Malaysia Day Care Centre** (tentative).
6. The organiser reserves the rights to amend the rules, change or postpone the date, or cancel the event if it is deemed necessary.
7. Entry Fees are as follows :
 - a) RM 200 per person (with accommodation on a twin sharing basis) for driver/navigator/2 passengers
 - b) ***The fee will include 1 night stay at Swiss-Garden Resort & Spa, Kuantan , 1 Prize Presentation Ceremony BBQ Dinner & 1 Breakfast***
8. The flag off will take place at :

9. The decision of awarding prizes and points by the judges will be final.

11. At least 1 team member from each team must attend the Registration and Briefing and he/she/they shall be responsible for disseminating all information provided at the briefing session to all other team members.
12. Competition numbers and various car stickers provided by the Organiser must be placed on participating vehicle as directed by the Organiser, and these must remain on the vehicle throughout the Hunt. No other form of advertising other than those provided by the Organiser shall be permitted.
13. Participants are required to comply with the dress code for the event as determined by the Organiser.
14. All materials of whatsoever nature in relation to the Hunt (whether submitted as a "found treasure" in the Hunt or otherwise) shall belong to the Organiser and no participant shall have any claim thereto.
15. The Organiser shall be entitled to use any materials derived from the event in any form or for any purpose that the Organiser deems fit.
